Students must apply in the spring of their sophomore year.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Panther Academy</p> <p>Option available for seniors who have met all of their high school graduation requirements. Must take one college course per semester.</p>

 - Offered free of charge by the college
 - Must take and pass before able to begin courses that need it as a prerequisite

Why Early College?

- Purpose

- Establish a partnership that creates a unique and exemplary educational opportunity to recognize and prepare MTHS for college level coursework while concurrently completing their high school diploma equivalences.

- Process

- Enhance the existing relationship between ACCC and MTHS by involving both institutions in integrated and cooperative curriculum alignment, which will enhance experiences and opportunities at both institutions.

Application Process

1. Application due- Spring of Sophomore Year
 - a. Including Teacher Recommendations
2. Committee review - Applications will be reviewed using multiple measures, including transcripts, by the Program Review Committee.
3. Acceptance letters sent
4. Commitment to the program
5. ***Students will map out curriculum with ACCC Advisor***

Requirements During the Program

The rigor involved requires commitment, organization, and the ability to seek help when needed. If your child is not being successful, they may be removed from the program.

- Receive a grade of C or better.
- Take and Pass the Accuplacer test.
- Pay the applicable fees.
- Meet with guidance to maximize access to dual credit course offerings.

Scheduling and Course Payment

Guidance will meet and schedule each student once selected for the program. Payment for dual and concurrent courses is made directly through ACCC Student Portal. An ACCC academic advisor will help students map out progress towards graduation.
