# What is a community college?

- ▶ It is a two-year college providing an affordable post-secondary education. Upon completion of the pre-requisite courses, a student earns an associate's degree. A student can then transfer the associate's degree to a 4-year university to put toward a bachelor's degree.



# NJ Dreamers


- The New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application allows undocumented students enrolled in eligible New Jersey colleges and universities to apply for state financial aid.
- Complete this application if you are not a United States citizen or eligible noncitizen and meet all of the following criteria:
  - You are not eligible to file the FAFSA
  - Attended a New Jersey high school for at least three (3) years
  - Graduated from a New Jersey high school **or** received the equivalent of a high school diploma in New Jersey
  - Registered for Selective Service (male students only)
  - Are able to file an affidavit stating that you will file an application to legalize your immigration status **or** will file an application as soon you are eligible to do so

# Early College Programs

Opportunities to earn college  
credits before completion of  
high school



- 
- ▶ **Dual Credit:** Dual credit courses are taught by high school teachers who meet college-level educational standards at the high school
  - ▶ **Concurrent Credit:** Concurrent enrollment courses are taught by Atlantic Cape faculty in a variety of locations: including at the high school, at any one of our Atlantic Cape's three campuses, or online.

# Costs for Courses

## Dual Credit:

**\$59.30** per credit

3 Credit Course=**\$177.90**

4 Credit Course=**\$237.20**

## Concurrent Credit:

Courses taught at the high school: **\$105** per credit with  
no additional costs for fees

Courses taught at an Atlantic Cape Campus: **\$146.10** per credit  
plus fees (tuition rates are higher for Aviation Studies and Culinary  
Arts courses )

# How to enroll in courses?

## Dual Credit

1. Students meet with Guidance Department to review courses and discuss eligibility to take course
2. Students fill out Atlantic Cape High School Admissions Application
3. Students will fill out registration form and submit form back to Guidance Department

## Concurrent Credit

1. Students meet with Guidance Department to review courses and discuss eligibility to take course
2. Students fill out Atlantic Cape High School Admissions Application
3. Students will need to take the Accuplacer Exam or have necessary SAT/ACT scores to take course
4. Students will fill out registration form and submit form back to Guidance Department
