Pursuing an Associate Degree

The Panther-Buccaneer Early College High School program offers dual enrollment for MTHS students at Atlantic Cape Community College (ACCC), giving them a head start in their pursuit of a college degree. The courses are offered at a reduced price, so students can earn degrees for a fraction of what it would cost to attend after graduation.

MTHS offers 30 dual credit courses with ACCC; students' other 30 credits must be taught by ACCC.

There are multiple opportunities for students to take these classes. MTHS offers concurrent courses where college professors come into MTHS classrooms or instruct students online. Students also are able to participate in classes on the ACCC campus, as well as remotely.

Middle Township High School is one of 17 schools that participate in the Early College Program with ACCC, which signed on to the program in November 2019.

Program Requirements

The rigorous Panther-Buccaneer Early College Program requires commitment, organization, and the ability to seek help when needed. Students who are not being successful, may be removed from the program. To participate, students must have a grade of C or better, take and pass the ACCUPLACER test, pay the applicable fees, and meet with guidance to ensure maximum access to course offerings.

The ACCUPLACER is a series of tests that evaluate students' skills in reading, writing, and math to help college administrators place them in courses that match their skills.

Placement scores will be reviewed by the college and a pathway toward course scheduling will be determined based on academic needs.
