DRILL TEAM

COMMUNITY SERVICE



All cadets are required to complete five hours of community service each marking period. Many cadets complete these hours by volunteering as ushers at the Performing Arts Center for Middle Township Public School District events.

ACADEMIC TEAM

The Academic Team has a strong understanding of the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (NJROTC) curriculum. Cadets on the Academic Team participate in academic competitions at drill meets and for "postals" that are held at the school. ORIENTEERING TEAM



The Orienteering Team participates in orienteering meets in the fall and spring. Orienteering is a combination of cross-country running and land navigation. Cadets who prefer an alternative to running can walk the courses and still practice land navigation skills. CYBERPATRIOT TEAM



The CyberPatriot Team participates in a one-week camp in the summer, trains weekly throughout the academic year, and competes in cybersecurity competitions three times per year. Drill Teams can be armed or unarmed and can perform either basic drill movements or exhibition-style drill movements. The Drill Team practices throughout the entire school year so cadets can practice on the team when their other sports and activities are not meeting.
