Report cards are finalized digitally at the end of each marking period (45 days) through Power School. The distribution dates are posted on the district calendar and district website.

Parents are encouraged to participate in our **Parent Advisory Committee** that meets at least twice throughout the school year. Also, parents are encouraged to register on their child's various Remind Apps, Power School, our blackboard phone list and check our school's Facebook page/website to best receive important information throughout the school year. In addition, various events and organizations will ask for parent volunteers to help with events, such as the after-prom, the band, and various performance-based events.
